- 1.2 Identify and describe additives, spices, and binders in product formulations in terms of their use in the product.
- 1.3 Describe the process of checking hygiene issues in meat ingredients in terms of organisational requirements.

## Outcome 2

Prepare product formulations in a meat processing operation.

### Performance criteria

- 2.1 Check ingredients to ensure they meet product specifications in terms of organisational requirements.
- 2.2 Formulate product using recipes and product specifications in terms of organisational requirements.
