Welfare codes are available from the Ministry of Primary Industries (MPI) via www.mpi.govt.nz.
- Definitions

Hand operated saw refers to a power driven saw, where the positioning of the cuts is made manually.

Organisational procedures refer to documents that include: worksite rules, codes, and practices; equipment operating instructions; manufacturer's specifications; production specifications; documented quality management systems; and health and safety requirements, including the use of PPE.

Poultry portions refers to drum, wing, half frame; it excludes nine cut portions.

PPE refers to personal protective equipment such as protective clothing, gloves, safety glasses, headwear, footwear, hearing protection, safety devices.

Produce poultry portions using a hand operated saw.

- 1.1 The hand operated saw is prepared for operation.
- 1.2 The poultry is cut into portions using a hand operated saw to meet quality and throughput workplace production requirements.
