- 2.1 Describe metabolic diseases and health disorders associated with reproduction and calving in terms of the symptoms, causes, and treatments.
 - Range diseases and disorders include but are not limited to ketosis (acetonaemia), milk fever (hypocalcemia), prolapsed uterus, grass staggers (hypomagnesaemia), retained afterbirth (retained placenta).
- 2.2 Describe optimal calving performance in terms of feeding requirements.
- 2.3 Describe health requirements of calving in terms of the Code of Welfare: Sheep and Beef Cattle.
