On-farm procedures refer to the verbal or written instructions to staff on procedures for animal care, welfare, and management.

Outcomes and performance criteria

Outcome 1

Identify and report signs of good health and ill health in livestock.

Range appearance, stance, movement, breathing, excretory, injury, behaviour patterns.

Performance criteria

- 1.1 Identify healthy livestock in terms of the visible, observable symptoms.
- 1.2 Identify unhealthy livestock in terms of the visible, observable symptoms.
- 1.3 Report symptoms of ill health or other variations from normal.

Outcome 2

Check and report on livestock feeding and housing.

Performance criteria

- 2.1 Report abnormal animal feeding behaviour.
- 2.2 Report the condition of feed or water supplies.
- 2.3 Assess condition of housing and/or fencing structures and report findings.
