Evidence is required for either a rain gauge, maximum/minimum thermometer, and barometer readings; or a weather station.

Elements and performance criteria

Element 1

Gather and record information from a rain gauge, thermometer, and barometer; or weather station.

Performance criteria

- 1.1 Readings are obtained.
- 1.2 Information taken from readings are recorded.
