2 Definitions

Aquaculture associated activity refers to any activity that involves water and an aquatic species for which a resource consent is required but may not necessarily involve the cultivation or farming of the species. Examples include marine farming, spat catching, hatchery activities, land and sea based farms and processing activities.

Organisations refers to government, non-government, social, environmental, and industry stakeholders.

For the purpose of this unit standard candidates must select an aquaculture activity and provide evidence for the same activity for each element.
