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## **Guidance Information**

Produce a job safety analysis for a specified job.

- 2.1 Define the activity or task in terms of the work to be performed.
- 2.2 Identify the job steps in terms of the work to be performed.
- 2.3 Identify the potential hazards and associated risk ratings for each job step.
- 2.4 Identify control measures for hazards in accordance with the legal hierarchy of risk control measures.
- 2.5 Identify the person(s) responsible for implementing, monitoring, and reviewing the control measures in accordance with organisational requirements.
