2 Definitions

Load – may include hazardous goods.

Manual handling techniques include but are not limited to – lifting, lowering, carrying, pushing and pulling. It may also include team lifting.

Materials – may be loaded into process or packing equipment.

Organisational requirements – instructions to staff on policies and procedures which are documented in memo, electronic or manual format and are available in the workplace. These requirements include but are not limited to – site specific requirements, and company quality management requirements.

Work – may be undertaken in various work areas including production, and inward and outward stores.

Outcomes and performance criteria

Outcome 1

Demonstrate knowledge of the safe relocation of materials in a primary industry operation.

Performance criteria

1.1 Identify and describe storage system requirements.

Range

storage system requirements may include but are not limited to site and work area layout; signage and symbols used to identify storage and handling requirements, and contents of stores;

housekeeping for work area; record keeping;

evidence is required of two storage system requirements.

1.2 Identify and describe safety issues and safety practices.

Range

safety issues and safety practices may include but are not limited to – manual handling requirements and techniques, personal risks and capacity, quality assurance and food safety issues relating to materials handling responsibilities, hazard and emergency control

policies and procedures:

evidence is required for two safety issues and two safety

practices.

Outcome 2

Confirm load relocation requirements in a primary industry operation.

Performance criteria

- 2.1 Identify characteristics of goods or materials to be relocated to determine any risk factors.
- 2.2 Confirm destination and space storage requirements.
- 2.3 Confirm routes to be followed to minimise risk factors.
- 2.4 Identify manual handling techniques appropriate to the load in terms of legislative requirements.
- 2.5 Identify and describe risks to self, arising from manual handling in terms of strategies to minimise them.

Outcome 3

Relocate the load in a primary industry operation.

Performance criteria

- 3.1 Transport goods or materials using appropriate manual handling techniques in accordance with legislative requirements.
- 3.2 Relocate goods or materials without damage to goods, equipment or property, or injury to personnel.
