2 Definitions

Animal Product Processing Operation – is a processing operation which processes raw or secondary animal products, extracts and materials for human or animal consumption and includes both non-dairy and dairy processors (including dairy farm operators, transporters of products either raw, processed, for sale, end use or export and storage operators.

Industry requirements include but are not limited to – site specific requirements, company quality management requirements, hygiene, health and safety, regulatory and legislative requirements.

Organisational requirements – instructions to staff on policies and procedures which are documented in memo, electronic or manual format and are available in the workplace.

Range evidence is required in relation to two of – record keeping, monitoring, identification of risks, corrective action, reporting.

2.3 Explain the responsibilities and actions of employees under a risk management programme in an animal product processing operation.

Range evidence is required in relation to two of – record keeping, monitoring, identification of risks, corrective action, reporting.

Explain factors affecting a risk management programme in an animal product processing operation.
