- Definitions
 

*Animal Product Processing Operation* – is a processing operation which processes raw or secondary animal products, extracts and materials for human or animal consumption and includes both non-dairy and dairy processors (including dairy farm operators, transporters of products either raw, processed, for sale, end use or export and storage operators.

*Industry requirements* include but are not limited to – site specific requirements, company quality management requirements, hygiene, health and safety, regulatory and legislative requirements.

*Organisational requirements* – instructions to staff on policies and procedures which are documented in memo, electronic or manual format and are available in the workplace.

Range key components include but are not limited to – responsibilities, scope, description, supporting systems, Hazard Analysis Critical Control Point, evaluation of risk factors; evidence of five components is required.

- 2.2 Explain the responsibilities and actions of employers under a risk management programme in an animal product processing operation.

Range evidence is required in relation to two of – record keeping, monitoring, identification of risks, corrective action, reporting.

- 2.3 Explain the responsibilities and actions of employees under a risk management programme in an animal product processing operation.

Range evidence is required in relation to two of – record keeping, monitoring, identification of risks, corrective action, reporting.

Explain factors affecting a risk management programme in an animal product processing operation.

#### Performance criteria

- 3.1 Explain the purpose of labelling in terms of a risk management programme.

- 3.2 Explain the concept of wholesomeness in terms of impacts on an organisational risk management programme.

- 3.3 Explain factors affecting a risk management programme in terms of compliance with animal welfare legislation.

- 3.4 Explain factors affecting a risk management programme in terms of compliance with human health legislation.
