*Nursery crop* refers to a crop of no less than 50 plants. *Workplace procedures* refer to policies and procedures on safety, operation, and production set down by the employer or host organisation for selecting, collecting, treating, and propagating seed.

3 All evidence presented in this unit standard must be in accordance with workplace procedures.

# Outcomes and performance criteria

## Outcome 1

Select and collect seeds for nursery crops and treat to enhance germination.

## Performance criteria

- 1.1 Select and collect seeds.
  - Range evidence of three seed species, and two different dormancy breaking treatments is required.
- 1.2 Apply treatments to selected seeds to break dormancy.
- 1.3 Treat seeds of susceptible species to reduce the risk of damping off.

# Outcome 2

Produce seedlings for each nursery crop.

Range evidence of three different plant species is required. evidence of fifty seedlings for each crop is required.

#### Performance criteria

- 2.1 Select or prepare the propagating media and select the container type.
- 2.2 Use seed sowing techniques appropriate for the species.
- 2.3 Select, monitor, and adjust the germination environment to maintain optimum conditions for seed germination.
- 2.4 Monitor germination, emergence, and seedling development and take corrective action.
- 2.5 Identify and label propagated plant material.
- 2.6 Maintain records of seed germination and seedlings development.
