### Guidance Information

- 1 It is recommended that people hold credits for Unit 20709, *Demonstrate knowledge of perchloroethylene for drycleaning*; and Unit 31291, *Demonstrate knowledge of hazardous substances relevant to Certified Handlers*, or demonstrate equivalent knowledge and skills, before being assessed against this unit standard.
- 2 Evidence must meet the following legislative and regulatory requirements:  
Consumer Information Standards (Care Labelling) Regulations 2000;  
Consumer Information Standards (Fibre Content Labelling) Regulations 2000;  
Hazardous Substances and New Organisms Act 1996;  
Health and Safety at Work Act 2015.
- 3 Definitions  
*Enterprise* – an organisation where training and/or assessment is taking place, and/or where the trainee is employed.  
*Enterprise procedures* – actions which comply with the policies, systems, and directives in a particular enterprise. Enterprise procedures must comply with the requirements of the Health and Safety at Work Act 2015, and subsequent amendments.

### Outcomes and performance criteria

#### Outcome 1

Describe the operation of a drycleaning machine.

**Performance criteria**

- 1.1 Controls and operating systems of a drycleaning machine are identified and described.

Range cleaning, filtration, drying, distillation, solvent flow.

- 1.2 Drycleaning processes are described according to job requirements and enterprise procedures.

**Outcome 2**

Demonstrate knowledge of emergency response procedures for drycleaning operations according to enterprise procedures.

**Performance criteria**

- 2.1 Emergency response management plan is described.

- 2.2 Evacuation procedure is described.

Range machine close down, evacuation.

- 2.3 Solvent containment procedures are demonstrated.

Range drains, water-ways, soil;  
evidence is required for at least two different solvents.
