- 3 Definitions  
*Infrastructure works sites* refer to sites with activity relating to any of: the construction and maintenance of infrastructure assets such as road, rail, port, airport, and utilities; demolition; bulk earthworks; quarrying; and handling of bituminous materials.  
*Notifiable work* is particular hazardous work as described in regulations, for which notice must be lodged with the government workplace safety authority 24 hours prior to commencement.  
*Permit*, for this unit standard, means any permit that addresses the protection of health, safety, the environment, and/or assets at infrastructure works sites.

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### Outcomes and performance criteria

#### Outcome 1

Demonstrate knowledge of current health and safety regulations relating to notifiable works.

**Performance criteria**

- 1.1 Types of notifiable works are identified in accordance with current health and safety regulations.
- 1.2 Explanation of who is responsible for making a notification is consistent with current health and safety regulations.
- 1.3 Explanation of requirements for lodging a notifiable notice is consistent with current health and safety regulations.
- 1.4 Types of works for which people must have a certificate of competence are identified in accordance with current health and safety regulations.

**Outcome 2**

Describe risk control measures for notifiable works typical of infrastructure works sites.

**Performance criteria**

- 2.1 Risk control measures are described in accordance with company requirements.
- Range at least three risk control measures relevant to notifiable works on own works site.

**Outcome 3**

Describe the types and purpose of permits typical of infrastructure works sites.

**Performance criteria**

- 3.1 Types of work that require a permit are identified and described in terms of purpose, terms and conditions, and organisations that issue them.
- Range two types of work relevant to own sector.
