### Outcomes and performance criteria

#### Outcome 1

Mount and dismount a horse while holding and preparing to lead another horse.

#### Performance criteria

- 1.1 Mount a horse while holding a horse to lead, maintaining control of ridden horse and led horse.  
  
 Range          mounting block, leg up.
- 1.2 Dismount from a horse maintaining control of ridden horse and led horse.

**Outcome 2**

Ride a horse and simultaneously lead another horse and describe road safety rules.

Range road, paddock.

**Performance criteria**

2.1 Demonstrate precautions in terms of safety of ridden horse and led horse.

Range may include – saddlery secured, restraint on led horse, length of rein or lead rope on led horse, position on road, turning across road, leading through gateways.

2.2 Describe rules for riding in terms of the Road Code.

2.3 Ride a horse and simultaneously lead another horse at a walk and a trot while maintaining control of ridden horse and led horse.
