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## Guidance Information

### 1 Definitions

*Event* refers to death, injury, illness, or incident detailed in the Health and Safety at Work Act 2015.

*Hazards* refer to those occurrences, processes, substances, or situations that are an actual or potential cause or source of harm and includes a person's behaviour where that behaviour has the potential to cause death, injury, or illness to a person (whether or not that behaviour results from physical or mental fatigue, drugs, alcohol, traumatic shock, or another temporary condition that affects a person's behaviour).

*Near miss* refers to an incident which did not result in injury, illness, or damage, but had the potential to do so.

*Organisation* may refer to any enterprise, business or education institution involved in training, engaging, controlling, or employing people.

*Organisation's procedures* are the documented requirements, procedures, and processes of the workplace.

*Others* may include workplace visitors, other employees, students, tutors, clients, property owners, or contractors.

### 3 Assessment against Outcome 2 of this unit standard may be based on evidence of demonstrated performance in a construction workplace or simulated construction environment designed to draw upon similar performances to that required in work.

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## Outcomes and performance criteria

### Outcome 1

Demonstrate knowledge of the organisation's health and safety procedures relevant to a building construction site.

#### Performance criteria

- 1.1 Identify personal protective equipment (PPE) for the workplace and describe its correct use in accordance with the organisation's procedures.
- 1.2 Identify and explain the organisation's procedures in relation to hazards to self, others, and the environment.
- 1.3 Explain event and near miss notification procedures in accordance with the organisation's procedures.
- 1.4 Explain the purpose of workplace emergency procedures in accordance with the organisation's procedures.

### Outcome 2

Apply the organisation's health and safety procedures under supervision for a building construction site.

#### Performance criteria

- 2.1 Select, correctly fit, and/or make ready for use, appropriate PPE.
- 2.2 Identify hazards and take measures to eliminate or minimise the hazards, in accordance with the organisation's procedures.  
  
 Range            may include but is not limited to – tools, equipment, environment, work practices, personal safety, safety of others; evidence of two is required.
- 2.3 Notify either an event or a near miss in accordance with the organisation's procedures.
- 2.4 Apply the organisations emergency procedures to either a workplace event or near miss.
