- Complex lologo mo e koli tuai performances require production of emotive energy; solo speaking role(s); leadership within a group.
- Definitions
Audience refers to a group of three or more people;
Fakaholoaga refers to the process by which something is learnt or knowledge is transmitted;
Lologo mo e koli tuai refers to traditional chants;
Maaga is any one of the 14 villages that the learner identifies with through either matrilineal or patrilineal lines, or self-identifies through acceptable fakaholoaga;
Pulotu refers to Niue village or community recognised and/or appointed experts.
- Assessment against this unit standard will occur in group situations, but assessment must be of individual competence.

Outcomes and performance criteria

Outcome 1

Perform complex lologo mo e koli tuai for an audience.

Range a total of three different lologo mo e koli tuai, one with and one without set actions.

Performance criteria

- 1.1 Performance includes evidence of consistent rhythm, stance, posture, and responding to cues as required for a lologo mo e koli tuai.
- 1.2 Performance is sustained throughout each lologo mo e koli tuai.

- 1.3 Performance includes actions that express an idea relevant to the occasion and lologo mo e koli tuai.
- 1.4 Performance includes evidence solo role(s) that show use of emotive effect and leadership as required for a lologo mo e koli tuai.
