Maaga is any one of the 14 villages that the learner identifies with through either matrilineal or patrilineal lines, or self-identifies through acceptable fakaholoaga; *Pulotu* refers to Niue village or community recognised and/or appointed experts; *Fakaholoaga* refers to the process by which something is learnt, or knowledge is transmitted;

Traditional refers to a specific body of knowledge and practice held by pulotu, which is imparted to learners through community resources such as cultural leaders and advisors.

Create dyes using traditional Niue processes.

1.1 Materials are selected and prepared using traditional Niue processes to produce a range of dye colours.

Range three different colours, one of which must be a gloss finish.
