- 2 Safe practices for the handling of dyes should be demonstrated to ensure the health and safety of self and others.
- 3 Definitions
Maaga is any one of the 14 villages that the learner identifies with through either matrilineal or patrilineal lines, or self-identifies through acceptable fakaholoaga;
Pulotu refers to Niue village or community recognised and/or appointed experts;
Fakaholoaga refers to the process by which something is learnt, or knowledge is transmitted;
Traditional refers to a specific body of knowledge and practice held by pulotu, which is imparted to learners through community resources such as cultural leaders and advisors.

Outcomes and performance criteria

Outcome 1

Create dyes using traditional Niue processes.

Performance criteria

- 1.1 Materials are selected and prepared using traditional Niue processes to produce a range of dye colours.

 Range three different colours, one of which must be a gloss finish.
- 1.2 Dye colour is tested using traditional Niue processes to ensure intended colour is achieved.
