- 2 Definitions

Fakaholoaga refers to the process by which something is learnt or knowledge is transmitted:

Maaga is any one of the 14 villages that the learner identifies with through either matrilineal or patrilineal lines, or self-identifies through acceptable fakaholoaga; Pulotu refers to Niue village or community recognised and/or appointed experts; Traditional refers to a specific body of knowledge and practice held by pulotu, which is imparted to learners through community resources such as cultural leaders and advisors;

Weaving techniques are Tia (close weave), Lalaga (open weave) and Fili (plaiting).

Outcomes and performance criteria

Outcome 1

Produce craft products using traditional Niue weaving techniques.

Range three different types of woven craft products using two traditional weaving techniques in each.

Performance criteria

- 1.1 Materials selected are consistent with requirements for shape and purpose of the woven craft product.
- 1.2 Each completed woven craft product achieves its intended shape and purpose.
- 1.3 Each completed craft product is produced according to traditional Niue weaving techniques.
