- 2 Definitions
Fakaholoaga refers to the process by which something is learnt or knowledge is transmitted;
Maaga is any one of the 14 villages that the learner identifies with through either matrilineal or patrilineal lines, or self-identifies through acceptable fakaholoaga;
Moui Niue is Niue life;
Pulotu refers to Niue village or community recognised and/or appointed experts;
Religions, for the purposes of this unit standard, refers to different religions or different Christian denominations.

Outcomes and performance criteria

Outcome 1

Identify a range of religions practised by Niue people.

Performance criteria

- 1.1 At least four religions practised are identified, with indication of the level of support for each, in the villages of Niue and overseas.
- 1.2 Distinguishing features in the practice of the selected religions are identified.
 Range at least four distinguishing features for each religion.

Outcome 2

Describe the origin, and impact on moui Niue, of each selected religion.

Performance criteria

- 2.1 Description includes details of its arrival in Niue, acceptance, recognition, and the identification of significant historical dates.
- 2.2 A significant impact of each religion on moui Niue life is identified.
