Prime, fill and sand a panel repair in the motor body industry.

Performance criteria

2.1 Panel to be primed and filled is prepared.

Range de-greasing, sanding, masking, free of dust and dirt.

2.2 Primer and/or primer filler is applied.

2.3 Primer or primer filler is sanded to a smooth level surface.
