### Guidance Information

- 1 Legislation relevant to this unit standard includes but is not limited to – Health and Safety at Work Act 2015, Resource Management Act 1991.
- 2 Definitions
  - Company specifications* – product specifications set by the company relating to materials, processes and practices.
  - Hide damage* – damage caused by the tanning process including handling practices and processes associated with fleshing, storage and preservation methods.
  - Organisational requirements* – instructions to staff on policies and procedures which are documented in memo, electronic or manual format and are available in the workplace.
  - Processed hides* – wet salted hides and skins processed in the leather processing industry.
- 3 Assessment information
  - All activities and evidence must be in accordance with organisational requirements.

### Outcomes and performance criteria

#### Outcome 1

Grade wet salted processed hides.

#### Performance criteria

- 1.1 Salted hides are graded to company specifications.
- 1.2 Hide damage is recorded.

- 1.3 Records of graded hides are maintained.
- 1.4 Batches of hides from different processing vessels are kept separate.
- 1.5 Graded hides are identified.
- 1.6 Communication is maintained with packers on hide types and grades.
- 1.7 Hide samples are taken and handled.
