- 1 Ngā pūkenga me ngā mātauranga tūtohu
Ko te whakatau kia mahi ngā tāngata e whai ana i tēnei paerewa i ngā paerewa mō te Reo Maori, ā, mō Tikanga hoki, kua rārangihia ki runga i te Rārangi Kōpaki o ngā Paerewa Aromatawai ki te kaupae 2, mā te whakaatu rānei i ngā pūkenga o te mātauranga ūrite ki taua kaupae.
- 2 Kei te rohe, kei te takiwā rānei o te hapū, o te iwi te horopaki o tēnei paerewa. Mēnā e nōhia ana te rohe, takiwā rānei e ētahi hapū, iwi atu, mā te kawa tangata whenua, manawhenua rānei e ārahi. Ehara i te mea he aukati i te kawa o hapū, o iwi kē; ēngari me tautoko tonu kia puta ai ngā tikanga Māori ki te whai ao, ki te ao mārama.
- 3 Mā te reo o te manawhenua anō e whakatau ko ngā whakamāramatanga kupu, tikanga rānei.
- 4 Hei aromatawai i te paerewa nei, tērā e rerekē ai te whakaatu, te whakamārama rānei i ngā mahi ēngari kaua anake ko ēnei he kōrero-ā-waha, he whakaata, he tuhituhi, he whakaari, he waiata, he haka, he mōteatea, he pūrākau, he pakwaitara.

- 1 Recommended skills and knowledge

- 2 The context of the assessment of this unit standard is limited to the local rohe or takiwā. Where local rohe are also occupied by a number of other iwi or hapū, the tangata whenua or mana whenua view will take precedence. Other iwi or hapū views should be encouraged in order to enrich and enhance understanding of key Māori concepts and practices.
- 3 The definitions of Māori words and concepts must be verified by the local iwi or hapū in the area the assessment takes place.
- 4 Assessment against this unit standard may include but is not limited to oral presentations, visual presentations, written presentations, whakaari, waiata, haka, mōteatea, pūrākau, pakiwaitara.
- 5 Definition
Social context – the context whereby customs and practices are conducted according to the responsibilities and obligations created by relationships within a group.

Outcomes and performance criteria

Outcome 1

Describe tikanga in relation to the management of wāhi tapu.

Range three tikanga is required and may include but is not limited to rāhui, pure, kawa, muru, tapu, karakia, utu.

Performance criteria

- 1.1 Tikanga associated with wāhi tapu are described in terms of their differing character and nature.
- 1.2 The reasons for tikanga associated with wāhi tapu are described in terms of their application.

Outcome 2

Describe tikanga associated with the transference and retention of kōrero tuku iho in relation to wāhi tapu.

Range three tikanga is required and may include but is not limited to taunahanaha, karakia, waiata, mōteatea, pūrākau, wānanga.

Performance criteria

- 2.1 The origins and importance of wāhi tapu tikanga are described in terms of kōrero tuku iho.
- 2.2 The reasons for tikanga associated with transference and retention of kōrero tuku iho pertaining to wāhi tapu are described in terms of their social context.
