Specifications refer to documented instructions (oral, written, graphic) and may include the following: job specifications from a supervisor or project specific drawings or requirements.

Workplace practice refers to the documented procedures specific to a work site which set out the standard and required practices of that workplace. For this unit standard, workplace includes residential dwellings.

Outcomes and performance criteria

Outcome 1

Prepare to perform basic flooring maintenance for a residential dwelling.

Performance criteria

- 1.1 The location of the work to be performed is identified from job specifications.
- 1.2 The work to be performed is described in terms of process and techniques to be used.
- 1.3 Quantities of materials are calculated from job specifications.
- 1.4 Equipment and tools are identified and selected to match job requirements.

Outcome 2

Perform basic flooring maintenance for a residential dwelling under supervision.

Performance criteria

- 2.1 The specified work is carried out and finished in accordance with job specifications.
- Tools, equipment, and personal protective equipment (PPE) are used in accordance with workplace practice.

Outcome 3

Complete work operations under supervision.

Performance criteria

- 3.1 Tools, equipment, and PPE are maintained and securely stored to prevent tampering and theft in accordance with workplace practice.
- 3.2 Site is cleared of all surplus components, equipment, tools, and debris in accordance with workplace practice.
