- Definitions
 

*Pork production section* – one part of the total pork production unit. A pork production unit is a collective term for several pork production sections. For example, a farrowing section, a grower section, and a dry sow section together make up a pork production unit.

*Programme* – the routine procedures required for feeding, maintaining health, housing and welfare of pigs.

*Veterinary guidelines* – advice received directly from veterinarians, or literature recommended by veterinarians.

*Workplace procedures* refer to the policies and procedures set by the employer or organisation on workplace safety, and conduct.

### Outcomes and performance criteria

#### Outcome 1

Establish work routines for a pork production section.

#### Performance criteria

- 1.1 Determine tasks to be accomplished on a daily and weekly basis.

- 1.2 Develop a task priority list that makes effective use of human and physical resources and optimises herd productivity.
- 1.3 Establish timing of routines and order of tasks to make effective use of human and physical resources and optimise herd productivity.

## Outcome 2

Implement and evaluate work routines for a pork production section.

### Performance criteria

- 2.1 Allocate tasks and identify expected outcomes.
- 2.2 Implement daily and weekly work routines.
- 2.3 Utilise human and physical resources effectively to achieve the work routine outcomes.
- 2.4 Evaluate the work routines to identify possible areas of improvement.
