Programme – the routine procedures required for feeding, maintaining health, housing and welfare of pigs.

Veterinary guidelines – advice received directly from veterinarians, or literature recommended by veterinarians.

Workplace procedures refer to the policies and procedures set by the employer or organisation on workplace safety, and conduct.

Establish work routines for a pork production section.

1.1 Determine tasks to be accomplished on a daily and weekly basis.
