- 2 Definition

Workplace procedures refer to the policies and procedures set by the employer or organisation on workplace safety, procedures, and conduct.

Outcomes and performance criteria

Outcome 1

Carry out daily routine husbandry checks of weaners.

Performance criteria

- 1.1 Check, report and adjust environmental conditions in accordance with workplace procedures.
- 1.2 Check water supply for flow rate in accordance with workplace procedures.
- 1.3 Take remedial action in the event of low water flow rate in accordance with workplace procedures.
- 1.4 Check weaners for behavioural and physical signs of ill health in accordance with workplace procedures.

1.5 Identify and report signs of ill health in weaners in accordance with workplace procedures.

- 1.6 Take remedial action in the event of ill health in accordance with workplace procedures.
- 1.7 Keep records of routine husbandry checks of weaners in accordance with workplace procedures.

Outcome 2

Check feeding and watering equipment, and feed weaners.

Performance criteria

- 2.1 Identify, report and remedy water supply problems in accordance with workplace procedures.
- 2.2 Check feed storage bins for adequate supply of feed in accordance with workplace procedures.
- 2.3 Report feed supply shortages in accordance with workplace procedures.
- 2.4 Check hoppers have feed and troughs are clean in accordance with workplace procedures.
- 2.5 Remove stale and/or contaminated feed prior to dispensing fresh feed in accordance with workplace procedures.
- 2.6 Calibrate feeding equipment to dispense accurate feed levels in accordance with workplace procedures.
- 2.7 Feed weaners in accordance with the feed schedule.
- 2.8 Identify and take remedial actions for weaners that are not eating in accordance with workplace procedures.

Outcome 3

Move weaners to the grower facility.

Performance criteria

- 3.1 Check receiving pen feeders have fresh feed and drinkers are working in accordance with workplace procedures.
- 3.2 Check route over which pigs are to be moved to ensure barriers are in required position and there are no obstacles.
- 3.3 Move weaner pigs with minimal stress and injury in accordance with workplace procedures.

3.4 Record transfer details in accordance with workplace procedures.
