- 2.1 Identify the correct pigs for loading and ensure that pigs are fit to load in accordance with workplace procedures and NZ Pork Fit to Load Guidelines.
- 2.2 Move pigs to the loadout area in accordance with workplace procedures and NZ Pork Fit to Load Guidelines.
- 2.3 Assist with loading pigs in accordance with workplace procedures and NZ Pork Fit to Load Guidelines.
- 2.4 Complete animal status declaration.
