Outcomes and performance criteria

Outcome 1

Preserve and store green skins.

Performance criteria

- 1.1 Preservation methods meet organisational requirements for the types of skins and the required holding periods.
- 1.2 Chemicals, formulations, and treatment times used to preserve skins meet organisational requirements for the types of skins and required period of preservation.
- 1.3 Preservation chemicals are handled and mixed in accordance with manufacturers, organisational, and statutory requirements.
- 1.4 Preserved skins are handled, packed, and stored to organisational requirements for the preservation method used.

- 1.5 Preserved skins are identified and recorded in accordance with organisational requirements.
