- 2 Definition
Company procedures mean the documented methods for performing work activities and include health and safety, environmental, and quality management requirements. They may refer to manuals, codes of practice, or policy statements.

Outcomes and performance criteria

Outcome 1

Identify and sort resources for recycling and recovery at a workplace.

Performance criteria

- 1.1 Waste materials that are, and/or have potential to be, recycled and recovered are identified in terms of workplace processes.
- 1.2 Resources for recycling and recovery are identified and requirements for removing them from the waste stream are described in accordance with company procedures.

Range description includes but is not limited to – health and safety controls, location of collection points, signage.

- 1.3 Resources are sorted and removed from the waste stream to a collection point for recycling and/or reuse in accordance with company procedures and recipient recycling company requirements.

Range three resources.

- 1.4 Sorted resources are checked for contamination in accordance with company requirements.
