Fly-tipping refers to the illegal deposit of any waste onto land (i.e. waste dumped or tipped on a site with no licence to accept waste).

Outcomes and performance criteria

Outcome 1

Produce information on separation at source for a resource recovery facility.

Range information in printed or published form;
source – either non-commercial or commercial.

Performance criteria

- 1.1 Information details facility location and access times.

- 1.2 Information details types of resources acceptable at the facility in sufficient detail to avoid contamination of the receptacles at the facility.
- Range for commercial users, information may include – grades of specific commodities.
- 1.3 For resources not acceptable at the facility, information advises against fly-tipping and recommends alternative contacts and/or facilities.
- Range two resources.
- 1.4 Information recommends systems for sorting at source.
- Range may include but is not limited to – bins, compaction unit, baler.
- 1.5 Information offers guidance on suitable containers for different types of resource.
- Range three resources.
- 1.6 Information is provided clearly at a reading level appropriate for the intended user.
