Service information may include– technical information for a vehicle, machine, or product detailing operation; installation and servicing procedures; manufacturer instructions; technical terms and descriptions; and detailed illustrations.
- 4 It is recommended that people hold credit for Unit 22801, *Demonstrate knowledge of adhesives and sealants used in the motor industry*, before being assessed against this unit standard.
- 5 Range
Evidence of two different adhesives and two different sealants are required for assessment.

Outcomes and performance criteria

Outcome 1

Use adhesives for bonding motor vehicle components.

Performance criteria

- 1.1 Surfaces are prepared, and components secured to enable bonding.
- 1.2 Adhesive is applied.
- 1.3 Curing time is observed.

Outcome 2

Use sealants to seal or weatherproof joints in vehicle bodywork.

Performance criteria

- 2.1 The correct sealants are selected.
- 2.2 The surface is prepared for sealant to be applied.
- 2.3 Sealant is applied.
