- 3 Definition:
Safe Ship Management systems on seafood vessels means any documented systems on a vessel, which are in place to comply with the Maritime Transport Act 1994, Maritime Rules Part 21, Marine Protection Rules, and the Health and Safety at Work Act 2015 and subsequent amendments.

Outcomes and performance criteria

Outcome 1

Implement safe ship management on a seafood vessel.

Performance criteria

- 1.1 Management and review of hazards in the Hazard Register are carried out in accordance with the Health and Safety at Work Act, and recorded in Safe Ship Management system documentation.

1.2 Requirements of the Safe Ship Management system are implemented in accordance with Maritime Rules Part 21 and the Health and Safety at Work Act, and recorded in Safe Ship Management system documentation.

Range includes but is not limited to – crew induction training, emergency drills, emergency systems checks, incident documentation, planned maintenance.

1.3 Pre-audit compliance checks of the Safe Ship Management system are carried out in accordance with Maritime Rules Part 21, Marine Protection Rules, and the Health and Safety at Work Act 2015, and recorded in Safe Ship Management system documentation.
