1.2 Job specifications are confirmed to be consistent with client's requirements and job sheet.

### Outcome 2

Obtain information for flooring quotation.

### Performance criteria

2.1 Measurement items are separated into pricing components.

Range components may include but are not limited to – labour, materials, plant, overheads, margins, equipment, waste, surface preparation.

- 2.2 Prices are obtained from material and/or service suppliers.
- 2.3 Prices are assessed against, and selected to meet, job specifications.

#### Outcome 3

Collate all priced components into a flooring quotation.

### Performance criteria

- 3.1 Priced items are collated to establish a quotation that meets the job specifications.
- 3.2 The quotation is recorded in accordance with workplace procedures.
