Performance criteria

- 2.1 Design and construction techniques used to enhance the built environment are identified and described in terms of their impact on the flooring industry.
- 2.2 Impacts are described in terms of budgetary constraints and regulatory requirements.

Range regulatory requirements may include but are not limited to those related to the Resource Management Act 1991, New Zealand Building Code, the Health and Safety in Employment Act 1992, Agenda 21.
