- Definitions

Outcomes and performance criteria

Outcome 1

Prepare to cut material in the industrial textile fabrication industry.

Performance criteria

- 1.1 Material is laid out.
- 1.2 Material is checked for defects.
- 1.3 Markings are identified and rechecked.

Outcome 2

Cut material to job specifications in the industrial textile fabrication industry.

Performance criteria

- 2.1 Material is cut.
Range evidence of six separate cuts of material is required.
- 2.2 Cut pieces are checked and labelled.
