- 1 Tapu and noa are inextricably interwoven throughout all kaupapa concerning Te Ara Nunumi Bereavement Pathways Māori. These elements will be explored in the context of this unit standard according to local whānau, hapū, iwi variation in tikanga.
- Tikanga are te ao Māori social norms exercised by whānau, hapū and iwi. The basic principles underpinning tikanga are common, but while there are some constants, the details of performance of tikanga, and their explanation, may differ. These differences may be at a rohe, iwi, hapū, whānau, or marae level.
- The context of the learning should include the tikanga of the local mana whenua (if capable) but learning others' tikanga is also encouraged. This is in order to enrich and enhance understanding of tikanga, and also adapting tikanga when operating in unprecedented situations such as a global pandemic.
- 4 Assessment against this standard must consider local marae, whānau, hapū, or lwi variation with regard to the concepts covered in the standard.
