ACE refers to annual catch entitlement.

Outcome 1

Describe the fishing permits and registrations required by the Fisheries Act 1996.

Range may include but is not limited to – fishing permit, vessel registration, transfer of ACE, transfer of quota;
evidence of two is required.

- 1.1 Describe the purpose of the fishing permits and registrations.

- 1.2 Describe the procedures for preparing and submitting the applications for the fishing permits and registrations.
- 1.3 Describe the requirements for maintaining the currency of the fishing permits and registrations.

Outcome 2

Prepare and submit the applications for the fishing permits and registrations required by the Fisheries Act 1996.

Range may include but is not limited to – fishing permit, vessel registration, transfer of ACE, transfer of quota; evidence of two is required.

Performance criteria

- 2.1 Prepare the applications for the required fishing permits and registrations.
- 2.2 Submit the applications for the required fishing permits and registrations.
