Outcomes and performance criteria

Outcome 1

Demonstrate knowledge of, and setup a band saw to process seafood product.

Performance criteria

- 1.1 Describe the procedures for setting up a band saw.
- 1.2 Describe the band saw settings that allow product and process specifications, product flow, and product yield to be met.
- 1.3 Set up the band saw.

1.4 Use safe work practices while setting up the band saw.

1.5 Check the band saw is clean and ready for use.

Outcome 2

Demonstrate knowledge of, and shut down and clean a band saw.

Performance criteria

2.1 Describe the procedures for shutting down and cleaning a band saw.

2.2 Shut down and disassemble the band saw for cleaning.

2.3 Clean the band saw.

2.4 Reassemble the band saw after cleaning ready for use.

2.5 Use safe work practices during shutting down and cleaning.

Outcome 3

Maintain a band saw during seafood processing.

Performance criteria

3.1 Carry out maintenance of the band saw during production.

3.2 Carry out maintenance of the band saw at the end of production.

3.3 Identify and report maintenance needs outside of the expertise of the operator.
