Performance criteria

- 2.1 Describe the procedures for shutting down and cleaning a band saw.
- 2.2 Shut down and disassemble the band saw for cleaning.
- 2.3 Clean the band saw.
- 2.4 Reassemble the band saw after cleaning ready for use.
- 2.5 Use safe work practices during shutting down and cleaning.

Outcome 3

Maintain a band saw during seafood processing.

Performance criteria

- 3.1 Carry out maintenance of the band saw during production.
- 3.2 Carry out maintenance of the band saw at the end of production.
- 3.3 Identify and report maintenance needs outside of the expertise of the operator.
