- 3 Definitions  
*Company requirements* refer to instructions to staff on policy and procedures which are documented in memo or manual format and are available in the workplace. These requirements include but are not limited to – company specifications and procedures, work instructions, manufacturer specifications, product quality specifications and legislative requirements.  
*Service information* may include but is not limited to – technical information of a vehicle, machine, or product detailing operation; installation and servicing procedures; manufacturer instructions and specifications; technical terms and descriptions; and detailed illustrations. This may be accessed from the manufacturer.  
*Suitable tools and equipment* refer to industry approved tools and equipment that are recognised within the industry as being the most suited to complete the task in a professional and competent manner with due regard to safe working practices.
- 4 Assessment  
This unit standard is recommended for off-job in a provider environment.  
  
Evidence presented for assessment against this unit standard must be consistent with safe working practices and be in accordance with applicable manufacturer's specifications, service information, company and legislative requirements.

- 5 Recommended skills and knowledge  
Unit 24020, *Demonstrate knowledge of adhesive graphics in the motor industry*, or demonstrate equivalent knowledge and skills.

## Outcomes and performance criteria

### Outcome 1

Prepare to apply adhesive graphics to a vehicle or machine.

#### Performance criteria

- 1.1 Customer requirements are identified and verified.
- 1.2 Surface is cleaned and prepared.
- Range free of dirt, traffic film, wax and silicone polishes, oil, grease; cure time of new paint.
- 1.3 Suitable tools and equipment are identified and used.
- Range cleaning materials, measuring tape, chalk, disposable blade cutter, lubricant, squeegee.
- 1.4 Area where graphic is to be applied is identified and legibly marked.

### Outcome 2

Apply adhesive graphics to a vehicle or machine.

#### Performance criteria

- 2.1 Backing tape is removed and the graphic is applied in the specified place.
- 2.2 There are no defects on the graphic and the area is clean where the graphic is placed on the vehicle or machine.
- Range air bubbles, tearing, lifting.
- 2.3 Tools and equipment are clean and put away, and the work area is cleaned and dried.
