Outcome 2

Demonstrate drill movements.

Range drill movements must be demonstrated on at least three occasions, minimum of at least one formal parade; drill movements must comply with the service drill manual for drill movements from NZAP818, NZP6 or BR1834/NZ Supplementary.

Performance criteria

2.1 Demonstrate parade ground entry movements and positioning.

Range forming up, attention, standing at ease, standing easy, side pacing, forward pacing, backward pacing.

- 2.2 Dress as a member of a squad.
- 2.3 Demonstrate movements at the halt.

Range left turn, right turn, about turn, inclines, dismiss.

2.4 Demonstrate marching skills.

Range marching, halting, wheeling left and right in quick time, turnings on the march, change step.

2.5 Demonstrate paying of compliments.

Range eyes left or eyes right, paying of compliments with head dress on.

2.6 Demonstrate open and close order march.
