<b>Purpose</b>	<p>This unit standard is intended for people who are members of the New Zealand Cadet Forces or those who are interested in the New Zealand Defence Force.</p> <p>People credited with this unit standard are able to: demonstrate knowledge of basic concepts of risk management; and complete a risk management plan for an NZCF activity.</p>

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### Guidance Information

- 1 This unit standard assesses introductory knowledge of the concepts of risk management as they apply to NZCF activities.
- 2 All knowledge and practice requirements must comply with the relevant environmental, regulatory, and legislative requirements, including the Health and Safety at Work Act 2015, as well as the policy and training manuals for RNZN, NZA, RNZAF and/or NZCF.
- 3 Training manuals relevant to this unit standard include NZCF 161 (Risk Management) and available upon request from New Zealand Cadet Forces. *Outdoor Safety - Risk Management for Outdoor Leaders*, available from New Zealand Mountain Safety Council.

*NZA* is the New Zealand Army;  
*NZCF* is the New Zealand Cadet Forces;  
*RNZN* is the Royal New Zealand Navy;  
*RNZAF* is the Royal New Zealand Air Force.

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### Outcomes and performance criteria

#### Outcome 1

Demonstrate knowledge of basic concepts of risk management.

**Performance criteria**

- 1.1 Define the term risk, and the possible values of risk in accordance with NZCF training manuals.  
Range values include – absolute risk, real risk, perceived risk.
- 1.2 Describe the importance of risk management in accordance with NZCF training manuals.
- 1.3 Identify the risk factors in terms of people, equipment, and environment in accordance with NZCF training manuals.
- 1.4 Describe risk reduction strategies in accordance with NZCF training manuals.  
Range strategies include - retain, reduce, avoid, transfer.

**Outcome 2**

Complete a risk management plan for an NZCF activity.

Range three different activities.

**Performance criteria**

- 2.1 Identify possible risk factors in terms of people, equipment, and environment in accordance with NZCF training manuals.
- 2.2 Plan strategies to manage the risks from 2.1 in accordance with NZCF training manuals.
