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### Outcomes and performance criteria

#### Outcome 1

Sort glass containers for recycling and reuse.

#### Performance criteria

- 1.1 Job requirements are confirmed in accordance with company procedures.
- 1.2 Hazards of working with glass and glass sorting equipment are identified, assessed, and controlled in accordance with company procedures and legislation.
- 1.3 Sorting of glass containers separates reject containers from others and stores them in accordance with company procedures.

1.4 Sorting of glass containers aggregates them in accordance with company procedures and job instructions.

Range containers may be sorted to crates, bins, or a bath depending on workplace requirements.

1.5 Sorting of glass containers results in minimal breakage of containers.
