Outcomes and performance criteria

Outcome 1

Clean the milking plant, and vats or silos.

Performance criteria

- 1.1 Calculates detergent quantities for milking plant cleaning in accordance with the establish plan cleaning routine.
- 1.2 Implements plant cleaning routine in accordance with workplace procedures.
- 1.3 Sets up milking plant for next milking in accordance with workplace procedures.

Outcome 2

Clean farm dairy and yards after milking.

Performance criteria

- 2.1 Cleans farm dairy and yards hygienically.
- 2.2 Cleans farm dairy and yards safely without risk of damage to equipment or facility.
- 2.3 Sets up farm dairy and yards for the next milking in accordance with workplace procedures.
