#### Outcome 1

Range evidence is required for at least one of – hay bales, silage, baleage, grain, crop residue.

#### Performance criteria

1.1 Load feed required for daily feed-out on vehicle in preparation for transport to livestock.

1.2 Place feed in paddock.

Range may include but is not limited to consideration of – prevailing weather conditions, contour of land, location of previous feed-out.

- 1.3 Manage feed left over from previous day in accordance with on-farm procedures.
