- 2.2 The explanation includes the benefits of the different types of graders available to grade single seed oysters.

Range evidence of three benefits per grader type.

**Outcome 3**

Carry out the grading of single-seed Pacific oysters.

**Performance criteria**

- 3.1 Carry out the grading of single-seed Pacific oysters in accordance with company requirements.
