Definitions

Company requirements refer to instructions to staff on policy and procedures that are communicated in an oral or written form. These requirements must include legislation and safety requirements and may include but are not limited to – manufacturers' instructions, industry codes of practice and standards.

Monitoring refers to the collection of data.

Elements and performance criteria

Element 1

Explain the monitoring and record keeping requirements for maintaining control of production of single-seed Pacific oyster farm grow-out systems.

Performance criteria

1.1 The explanation includes the type of data to be monitored and the expected frequency of monitoring to maintain control of production of single-seed Pacific oysters on farm grow-outs in accordance with company requirements.

Range evidence is required for six types of data.

1.2 The explanation includes the record keeping requirements used to maintain control of production of single-seed Pacific oysters on farm grow-outs in accordance with company requirements.

Element 2

Apply monitoring and record keeping techniques for single-seed Pacific oysters on farm grow-out systems.

Performance criteria

2.1 Data is collected and recorded in accordance with company requirements.

2.2 Data is interpreted and action is taken in accordance with company requirements.

Please note

Providers must be accredited by the Qualifications Authority, or an inter-institutional body with delegated authority for quality assurance, before they can report credits from assessment against unit standards or deliver courses of study leading to that assessment.
