- 1.2 The explanation includes the record keeping requirements used to maintain control of production of single-seed Pacific oysters on farm grow-outs in accordance with company requirements.

Outcome 2

Apply monitoring and record keeping techniques for single-seed Pacific oysters on farm grow-out systems.

Performance criteria

- 2.1 Collect and record data in accordance with company requirements.
- 2.2 Interpret data and take action in accordance with company requirements.
