- 2 All evidence presented in this unit standard must be in accordance with workplace procedures.
- 3 For assessment purposes, installing posts must consider any bisecting of contour angle. Posts can be installed using a post driver, post borer or by digging. Footing a post can be undertaken using a primary or intermediate post.
- 4 Definition  
*Workplace procedures* refer to policies and procedures on safety, operation, and production set down by the employer or host organisation for a fencing activity and includes manufacturer's guidelines for use of equipment and materials.

### Outcomes and performance criteria

#### Outcome 1

Locate the position of, and install, primary and intermediate posts for fencing.

#### Performance criteria

- 1.1 Locate primary and intermediate post positions in relation to terrain and fence design.
- 1.2 Install primary posts plumb, in line, and in accordance with fence design height.
- 1.3 Foot a post according to fence installation requirements.
- 1.4 Install all intermediate posts in accordance with fence design height.
